Since you are participating in the *Enhancing Student Performance* protocol as a Supplementary Educational Organization, accreditation is for a period not to exceed five years, ending on **November 1, 2010**. Should you choose to elect to continue with the second phase of this protocol, the special purpose accreditation may be extended for the next five years.

In addition, over the next five years, the organization will be expected to continue to meet Commission Standards for Supplementary Educational Organizations as well as assume the following obligations:


1. The organization must notify the Commission office prior to making any substantive changes to the objectives for which the school received accreditation.
2. Just prior to the close of the fourth accreditation year, the organization should re-initiate the planning process for the purposes of developing a new five-year improvement plan and preparing for the Middle States mini-visit team (during the **Spring of 2010**) in order to extend the accreditation for another five years. A comprehensive progress report will be due **January 2010** and must be received before the mini-visit will be scheduled. Detailed instructions for this report will be sent to you a year prior to its due date describing the contents of the report. Renewal of accreditation for a second five-year term will be based on the results of the report from the mini-visit team.

5. The organization will pay annual membership dues.
6. The organization will complete an annual Nomination form, listing faculty members recommended and willing to serve on visiting committees. It is expected, by Commission policy, that your organization releases at least one staff member per year to serve on teams.


